Fourth Quarter Focus : Bearing the Fruits of Righteousness

"Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God" Phil 1:11).

"Unto Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen" (Eph. 3:21)

TITLE : THE GAINS BELIEVERS HAVE IN WINNING CHRIST

TEXT : Phil 3:7-8

7 But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ.

8 Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord: for whom I have suffered the loss of all things, and do count them but dung, that I may win Christ.

INTRODUCTION

There is much to gain when believers choose to win Christ instead of what the world can offer. Paul enumerates some of them.

A) The gain of having a new knowledge (vs 7,8).

Phil 3:7-8, "But what things were gain to me, those I counted loss for Christ. Yea doubtless, and I count all things but loss for the excellency of the knowledge of Christ Jesus my Lord..."

"He is no fool who gives up what he cannot keep to gain what he cannot lose" (John Elliot).

The knowledge of Christ is far more valuable than what may see as gain in the world. Such knowledge, Paul says, is excellent knowledge.

B) The gain of having a new righteousness (v 9).

Phil 3:9, "And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness...but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith."

Isa 64:6, "But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags..."

Referring to Israel, Paul says, Rom 10:3, "For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted themselves unto the righteousness of God."

C) The gain of having a new power (v 10).

Phil 3:10, "That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death."

Such power is realized when we have the fellowship of his suffering and when we are made conformable unto His death. This power is seen when we can rise victorious over sin and all its clutches. Paul says, Rom 6:11, "...reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord."

D) The gain of having a new goal (vs 11-17).

Phil 3:12, "Not as though I had already attained, either were already perfect: but I follow after, if that I may apprehend that for which also I am apprehended of Christ Jesus."

In saying this, Paul actually says, "It is not that I have already obtained it or already reached the goal — no, my ultimate goal is to

take hold of that for which Christ took hold of me.

2 Tim 1:9. Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace..."

Eph 1:4, "According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love."

E) The gain of having a new hope (vs 20,21).

Phil 3:20-21, "For our conversation is in heaven; from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself."
