TITLE : BIBLICAL GUIDELINES IN CHOOSING CANDIDATES
TEXT : 2 Sam 23:3, "...He that ruleth over men must be just, ruling in the fear of God."

INTRODUCTION

Our best guide in life is the Word of Truth. What it teaches applies to every aspect of our lives, personal, family, business, community, even as we take the responsibility to select the candidates for the current national and local elections next month.

The wise man Solomon says in Ps 127:1, "Except the Lord build the house, they labour in vain that build it: except the Lord keep the city, the watchman waketh but in vain." What this passage tells us is, even as a nation, we cannot put God outside of governance. He remains the Builder of our Nation-Home. His Word is our Blue-Print.

May this series of lessons equip us as a people of God who submit ourselves to the ordinance of man.

11) Choose people who will govern not simply from the point of view of title and power. Rather choose people who will make a government that is revered and regarded greatly by all our people.

Rom 13:5, "Wherefore ye must needs be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake." KJV

Rom 13:5, "Another reason to obey, besides fear of punishment, is for the sake of conscience." CJB

We want a government that is not just feared by those that do evil, but one that is revered and regarded greatly by our people. Our people go overseas because they feel that government does not care.

12) Choose people who will continuously attend to the faithful stewardship of both the taxes of our people and resources of our beloved land.

Rom 13:6, "For for this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's ministers, attending continually upon this very thing." KJV

Let us choose candidates who will be faithful and true in stewarding our taxes and natural resources. This is an obvious quality.

13) Choose people who exhibit true faithfulness and loyalty to all, whether man, institution, creed or country.

Rom 13:7, "Render therefore to all their dues: tribute to whom tribute is due; custom to whom custom; fear to whom fear; honour to whom honour." KJV

Rom 13:7, "Pay everyone what he is owed: if you owe the tax-collector, pay your taxes; if you owe the revenue-collector, pay revenue; if you owe someone respect, pay him respect; if you owe someone honor, pay him honor." CJB

Let us choose candidates who show faithfulness and loyalty to all. We need people in government who stay loyal to our country and people, who will not exchange our beloved land for other nations. Who will be true patriots.

Luke 16:10, "He that is faithful in that which is least is faithful also in much: and he that is unjust in the least is unjust also in much." KJV

14) Choose people who have a clear program of governance that will uplift the poor, needy, afflicted and persecuted.

Ps 82:3-4, "Defend the poor and fatherless: do justice to the afflicted and needy. Deliver the poor and needy: rid them out of the hand of the wicked." KJV

Ps 82:3-4, "Give justice to the weak and fatherless! Uphold the rights of the wretched and poor! Rescue the destitute and needy; deliver them from the power of the wicked!" CJB

Let us choose candidates who have a platform of government that clearly defines how to address the needs of the poor, needy, afflicted and persecuted.

15) Choose people who will do everything in the fear of God, faithfully and with a perfect heart.

2 Chron 19:9, "And he charged them, saying, Thus shall ye do in the fear of the Lord, faithfully, and with a perfect heart." KJV

2 Chron 19:9, "The king charged them, Do this in the fear of the Lord, faithfully, with integrity and a blameless heart." AMP

Let us choose candidates who will put their whole being into what they should be as government officials, whether national and local.
