LIGHTHOUSE BBC HOLDS ALL FAMILIES OVERNIGHT OUTING ON JUNE 3-4.

Everyone in Lighthouse BBC will agree that we
have done much in the many ministries we have
since the start of the pandemic in March of
2020. And while we had some fellowship events, they
were only done through Zoom and other digital
platforms. This is true not just for the Lighthouse
BBC Tatalon alone, but for the related works in
Metro Manila.

For this reason, Pastor Reuben and the rest of the
pastors and leaders of the church decided to hold an
All Lighthouse Overnight Family Outing on June
3-4 at the beautiful Tribe of Judah Events Center in
Baras, Rizal which is just about an hour and a half
drive from Quezon City.

The Tribe of Judah Events Center can
accommodate families and large groups and features
private rooms for families (with available hot shower
bathrooms), swimming pools, games and sports
facilities and large function halls. There are also

areas for camping tents and bonfire.

Pastor Reuben has assigned the SWYP and the LYF
groups to hand the registration and program and
this applies to all Lighthouse related works in Metro
Manila.

Registration fee is set at P1,500.00 inclusive of 3
meals and the use of all facilities. The church shall
provide subsidy for those who have limited resources
enough for the fees. Those who would like to avail of
such may indicate the need in the registration form.

Everyone should be at the site for check in by 1pm
on Friday, June 3. Check out will be after lunch on

TITLE : THE VOICE OF THE PEOPLE

TEXT : 1 Samuel 8:7, "And the LORD said unto Samuel, Harken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them."

INTRODUCTION

When did human government begin?

From the creation, it is evident that everything began with God's rule. But man sinned and everyone fell into sin. And sin became worse, from disobedience to murder to all wickedness.

Gen 6:5, "And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually."

1) The beginning of human rule and order.

Before the flood, it was the "fugitive and vagabond Cain who built the first city, Enoch.

Gen 4:17, "And Cain knew his wife; and she conceived, and bare Enoch: and he builded a city, and called the name of the city, after the name of his son, Enoch."

After the flood, they were the sons of Noah, Japheth, Ham and Shem.

Gen 10:2-5

2 The sons of Japheth; Gomer, and Magog, and Madai, and Javan, and Tubal, and Meshech, and Tiras.

3 And the sons of Gomer; Ashkenaz, and Riphath, and Togarmah.

4 And the sons of Javan; Elishah, and Tarshish, Kittim, and Dodanim.

5 By these were the isles of the Gentiles divided in their lands; every one after his tongue, after their families, in their nations.

Gen 10:6-12

6 And the sons of Ham; Cush, and Mizraim, and Phut, and Canaan.

7 And the sons of Cush; Seba, and Havilah, and Sabtah, and Raamah, and Sabtecha: and the sons of Raamah; Sheba, and Dedan.

8 And Cush begat Nimrod: he began to be a mighty one in the earth.

9 He was a mighty hunter before the Lord: wherefore it is said, Even as Nimrod the mighty hunter before the Lord.

10 And the beginning of his kingdom was Babel, and Erech, and Accad, and Calneh, in the land of Shinar.

11 Out of that land went forth Asshur, and builded Nineveh, and the city Rehoboth, and Calah,

12 And Resen between Nineveh and Calah: the same is a great city.

Gen 10:18-20

18 And the Arvadite, and the Zemarite, and the Hamathite: and afterward were the families of the Canaanites spread abroad.

19 And the border of the Canaanites was from Sidon, as thou comest to

Gerar, unto Gaza; as thou goest, unto Sodom, and Gomorrah, and Admah, and Zeboim, even unto Lasha.

20 These are the sons of Ham, after their families, after their tongues, in their countries, and in their nations.

Gen 10:21-32

21 Unto Shem also, the father of all the children of Eber, the brother of Japheth the elder, even to him were children born.

22 The children of Shem; Elam, and Asshur, and Arphaxad, and Lud, and Aram.

23 And the children of Aram; Uz, and Hul, and Gether, and Mash.

24 And Arphaxad begat Salah; and Salah begat Eber.

25 And unto Eber were born two sons: the name of one was Peleg; for in his days was the earth divided; and his brother's name was Joktan.

26 And Joktan begat Almodad, and Sheleph, and Hazar-maveth, and Jerah,

27 And Hadoram, and Uzal, and Diklah,

28 And Obal, and Abimael, and Sheba,

29 And Ophir, and Havilah, and Jobab: all these were the sons of Joktan.

30 And their dwelling was from Mesha, as thou goest unto Sephar a mount of the east.

31 These are the sons of Shem, after their families, after their tongues, in their lands, after their nations.

32 These are the families of the sons of Noah, after their generations, in their nations: and by these were the nations divided in the earth after the flood.

2) The direction of human government after the flood.

Gen 11:1-9

1 And the whole earth was of one language, and of one speech.

2 And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there.

3 And they said one to another, Go to, let us make brick, and burn them thoroughly. And they had brick for stone, and slime had they for mortar.

4 And they said, Go to, let us build us a city and a tower, whose top may reach unto heaven; and let us make us a name, lest we be scattered abroad upon the face of the whole earth.

5 And the Lord came down to see the city and the tower, which the children of men builded.

6 And the Lord said, Behold, the people is one, and they have all one language; and this they begin to do: and now nothing will be restrained from them, which they have imagined to do.

7 Go to, let us go down, and there confound their language, that they may not understand one another's speech.

8 So the Lord scattered them abroad from thence upon the face of all the earth: and they left off to build the city.

9 Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the Lord did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the Lord scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.
