BAPTIST CHURCHES HOLD NATIONAL BAPTIST DAY CELEBRATION ON JAN 12

"Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers...do that which is good, and thou shalt have praise of the same: for he is the minister of God to thee for good" (Rom 13:1-4).

any who read the above verses only take the injunction of the Word of God for Christians to be subject to authorities. They never consider that this is followed by the instruction for us to "do that which is good" and to "submit yourselves...for the praise of them that do well. The National Baptist Day Act of 2023, known as the Republic Act #11897, recognizes the Baptist churches in the country "for the continuous pursuit of their evangelical mission to contribute to nation-building by establishing Christian schools that instill academic excellence and build character in individuals, and

churches that proclaim, teach and share Biblical principles for the betterment of society."

In recognition of this important contribution, the State, through this law promotes the observance of the second Thursday of January of every year as "National Baptist Day" and proclaim the same as a Special Working Holiday.

As it is, this law is concrete proof that the Word of God is true in saying, "Do that which is good, and thou shalt have the praise of the same." And this fact puts to silence "the ignorance of foolish men who use their liberty as a cloke of maliciousness" meaning, who use their liberty or freedom as an excuse for not contributing to anything that leads to the good of society, starting with the work of bringing the Gospel to people and contributing to the betterment of society. Such people never place themselves in the limelight so that they can "shine as lights in the world; holding forth the word of life" (Phil 2:15-16). They are nothing but loud critics who never contribute to bringing to the darkened corrupt world any "fruit of righteousness" that should result from their claim of having Christ in them.


