


kind of churches that we see in our day which are platformed on tradition and culture of this generation and not on the truth in which the churches in the New Testament walked.

TITLE: WHAT DEFINES AND MAKES AN EKKLESIA

Texts: Col 2:6-7, "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving."

INTRODUCTION

It is the Word of God that defines and makes the Ekklesia.

Ps 100:3, "Know ye that the Lord he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture."

Eph 2:10, "For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God hath before ordained that we should walk in them."

1 Cor 6:19-20, "What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's."

1 Peter 2:9-10, "But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: which in time past were not a people, but are now the people of God: which had not obtained mercy, but now have obtained mercy."

A) How we received Christ Jesus the Lord defines and makes us as Ekklesia 1) We received Christ Jesus the Lord

with certainty of the Gospel
Col 2:6, "As ye have therefore received
Christ Jesus the Lord..."

This word presents to us the time in our lives when we looked for answers anywhere but Christ; but we come to a point of therefore in our lives. A point of certainty on Christ,

Col 1:3-6, "We give thanks to God and the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ...for

the hope which is laid up for you in heaven, whereof ye heard before in the word of the truth of the gospel; which is come unto you, as it is in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as it doth also in you, since the day ye heard of it, and knew the grace of God in truth."

2) We received Christ Jesus the Lord being...

a)The Word

John 1:1-4, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life; and the life was the light of men."

John 1:9-12, "That was the true Light, which lighteth every man that cometh into the world. He was in the world, and the world was made by him, and the world knew him not. He came unto his own, and his own received him not.

But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name." - to be continued
