And we know that all these will not be realized overnight unless we are fully taught, equipped to manifest these qualities under any circumstances.


To be perfect means to be equipped with what we should be doing given any situation or circumstance in our lives as God's people.

# TITLE: WHAT DEFINES AND MAKES AN EKKLESIA

Texts: Col 2:6-7, "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving."

### INTRODUCTION

- A) How we received Christ Jesus the Lord defines and makes us as an Ekklesia.
  - 1) We received Christ Jesus the Lord with certainty of the Gospel. Col 2:6, "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord..."
  - 2) We received Christ Jesus the Lord being...

### a) The Word

John 1:1-4, "In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life; and the life was the light of men...as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name."

## b) The Only Begotten of the Father, full of Grace and Truth

John 1:14-17, "...the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth...And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace...grace and truth came by Jesus Christ."

### c) Eternal Life (union)

John 10:28-30, "...I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father,

which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. I and my Father are one."

1 John 5:13, "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

1 John 5:20, "...we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life."

### d)His forgiveness

Col 1:14, "In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins."

Eph 1:7, "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace."

1 Cor 6:11, "...ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God."

### e)His Spirit

John 3:34, "...he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him."

Rom 8:9-11, "ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.
