**TITLE : WHAT DEFINES AND MAKES AN
EKKLESIA**

Texts : Col 2:6-7, "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: Rooted and built up in him, and established in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving."

INTRODUCTION

A) How we received Christ Jesus the Lord defines and makes us as an Ekklesia.

1) We received Christ Jesus the Lord with certainty of the Gospel.

Col 2:6, "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord..."

2) We received Christ Jesus the Lord being... - continued -

c) Eternal Life (union)

John 10:28-30, "...I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand. My Father, which gave them me, is greater than all; and no man is able to pluck them out of my Father's hand. I and my Father are one."

1 John 5:13, "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God."

1 John 5:20, "...we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may

know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life."

d) His forgiveness

Col 1:14, "In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins."

Eph 1:7, "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace."

1 Cor 6:11, "...ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God."

e) His Spirit

John 3:34, "...he whom God hath sent speaketh the words of God: for God giveth not the Spirit by measure unto him."

Rom 8:9-11, "ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his. And if Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin; but the Spirit is life because of righteousness."

f) Christ Jesus the Lord

Col 2:6, "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him."

Col 3:23-24, "And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and unto men; knowing that of the Lord ye shall receive the reward of the inheritance: for ye serve the Lord Christ."

2 Thess 1:12, "That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the grace of our God and the Lord Jesus Christ."
