areas abroad, our leaders and key members diligently distribute themselves, all at the same time, doing the work needed to prepare our people and facilities for the Ekklesia Conference.

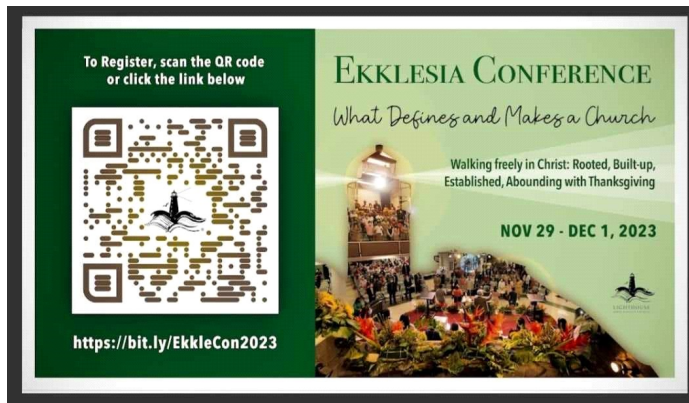

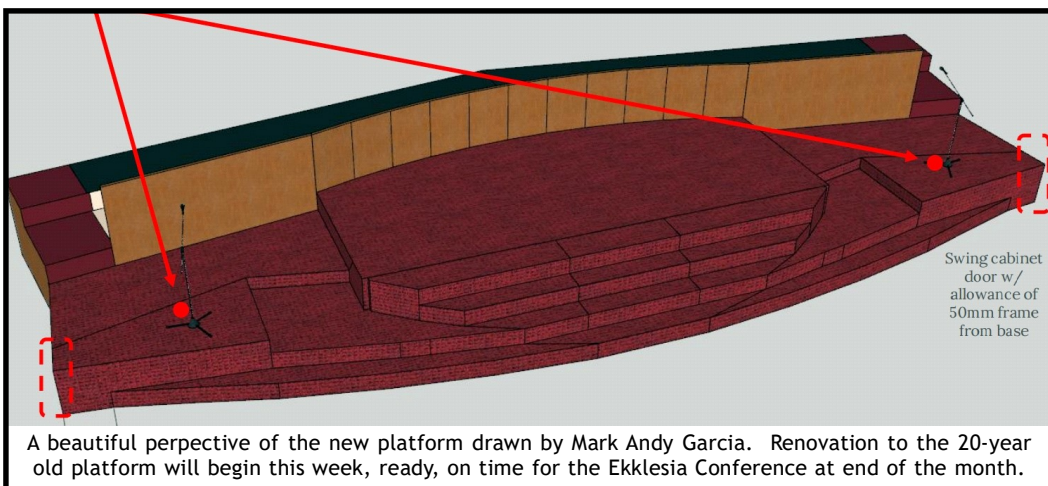

INTRODUCTION

The Ekklesia is a body of people who have received Christ Jesus the Lord and who walk in Him...

B)We are a people walking together in Him.

People who walk together is the most basic of what a church or Ekklesia can do.

- o We walk together with purpose.
- o We walk together towards a direction.
- o We walk together with distinction.
- o We walk together with leading.
- o We walk together with intention.

1)A people walking in the newness of life.

Rom 6:4, "...we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life."

Eph 4:17-21, "...walk not as other Gentiles walk, in the vanity of their mind, having the understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God through the ignorance that is in them, because of the blindness of their

heart...That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts; and be renewed in the spirit of your mind..."

2)A people walking in the Spirit.

Ezek 36:27, "And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them."

John 3:6, "That which is born of the flesh is flesh; and that which is born of the Spirit is spirit..."

Rom 8:9, "...ye are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if so be that the Spirit of God dwell in you. Now if any man have not the Spirit of Christ, he is none of his."

Gal 5:16-18, "This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh. For the flesh lusteth against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these are contrary the one to the other: so that ye cannot do the things that ye would. But if ye be led of the Spirit, ye are not under the law."

Gal 5:25, "If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit."

3)A people walking in truth.

3 John 4, "I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth."

John 17:14-17, "I have given them thy word; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as I am not of the world. I pray not that thou shouldest take them out of the world, but that thou shouldest keep them from the evil. They are not of the world, even as I am not of the world."

Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth."

Eph 4:20-21, "But ye have not so learned Christ; If so be that ye have heard him, and have been taught by him, as the truth is in Jesus."

1 John 5:20-21, "And we know that the Son of God is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, even in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life. Little children, keep yourselves from idols. Amen."
