We have much to appreciate concerning the Grace of God for us and in us.

A) The Grace of God saves

Eph 2:8-9
8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:
9 Not of works, lest any man should boast.

B) The Grace of God makes an Ekklesia

Acts 11:19-23

19 Now they which were scattered abroad upon the persecution that arose about Stephen travelled
as far as Phenice, and Cyprus, and Antioch, preaching the word to none but unto the Jews only.

20 And some of them were men of Cyprus and Cyrene, which, when they were come to Antioch,
spake unto the Grecians, preaching the Lord Jesus.

21 And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number believed, and turned unto the
Lord.

22 Then tidings of these things came unto the ears of the church which was in Jerusalem: and they
sent forth Barnabas, that he should go as far as Antioch.

23 Who, when he came, and had seen the grace of God, was glad, and exhorted them all, that with
purpose of heart they would cleave unto the Lord.

C) The Grace of God makes each one of us in His work

- The Grace of God gives gifts to each one

1 Cor 15:10

- The Grace of God sustains, strengthens and is sufficient to each one of us

D) The Grace of God enriches the Ekklesia and makes it abound

- As His Grace abound to each one, the same Grace makes the whole Ekklesia abound

5 That in every thing ye are enriched by him, in all utterance, and in all knowledge;
