INTRODUCTION

Phil 2:12-16

12 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling.

13 For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure.

14 Do all things without murmurings and disputings:

15 That ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world;

16 Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.

As Ekklesia of the Lord Jesus Christ, we take the words of the Apostle Paul to the Philippian church or Ekklesia as applicable to us even today. We take this as a letter also to us. And this means, we take these words seriously and with emphasis even in what we do today.

We take it seriously when Paul tells us, “Do all things without murmurings and disputings: that ye may be blameless and harmless, the sons of God, without rebuke, in the midst of a crooked and perverse nation, among whom ye shine as lights in the world; holding forth the word of life...”

He practically says, “Do everything without kvetching (habitually complaining or griping) or arguing, so that you may be blameless and pure children of God, without defect in the midst of a twisted and perverted generation, among whom you shine like stars in the sky, as you hold on to the Word of Life.

And adding, 1 Cor 15:58, he continues to say, “And you be steadfast, unmoveable, always abounding in this work of the Lord forasmuch as you know that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.”

The emphasis in our message today is on how the Apostle says, “holding forth the word of life.”

There is such beautiful correlation between the Living Word (Christ) and the written Word (the Bible) that certain Scriptures could well apply to either one. Such is the case with our text. The Philippians were exhorted to hold forth the Word of life, which presumably could mean either Christ, the Living Word, or else the Scriptures, which speak of eternal life.

1 Thess 2:13

13 For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.

BODY

Phil 2:16

“...Holding forth the word of life...”

Given the correlation between the Living Word, Who is Christ, and the Written Word, which is the Bible, we hold forth both! We hold forth the Truth, Who is Christ, and His Word, which is the truth.

John 17:17

17 Sanctify them through thy truth: thy word is truth.

1 Tim 3:15

15 But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is **the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.**

There is such beautiful correlation between the Living Word (Christ) and the written Word (the Bible) that certain Scriptures could well apply to either one. Such is the case with our text. The Philippians were exhorted to hold forth the Word of life, which presumably could mean either Christ, the Living Word, or else the Scriptures, which speak of eternal life.

A) There is correlation between the Living Word and the Written Word.

- Truth

John 14:6

6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.

8 How shall not the ministration of the spirit be rather glorious?

9 For if the ministration of condemnation be glory, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in glory.

10 For even that which was made glorious had no glory in this respect, by reason of the glory that excelleth.

11 For if that which is done away was glorious, much more that which remaineth is glorious.

B) We have responsibilities to both the Living Word and the Written Word because this correlation exists when we:

1) We preach and minister the Word

2 Tim 4:2

2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.

12 For the word of God is quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

2) We take the Word to heart and live our lives according to the word.
