Sound Doctrine. What is it for? Who benefits from it? Who applies it in their lives? Where is it applied?

A) Preachers are to deliver sound doctrine to God's people.

Sound doctrine means fitting and becoming to wholesome doctrine... which doctrine makes God's people to have the character and right living becoming of God's people.

Titus 2:1

2 But speak thou the things which become sound doctrine:

1 BUT [as for] you, teach what is fitting and becoming to sound (wholesome) doctrine [the character and right living that identify true Christians].

Doctrine, if it be sound, should translate to the becoming character, life and service of God's people. That they be profitable to the Lord in His Work.

B) Who applies sound doctrine in their lives?

These people which Paul mentions are those who are within the churches. Churches in those days are in households. They do not have their church buildings. Hence, the application of doctrine actually find their applications right in their very homes, communities, and workplaces.

Titus 2:2

Titus 2:9-10

- 18 Servants, be subject to your masters with all fear; not only to the good and gentle, but also to the froward.

13 Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ;

14 Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.

D) The authority that rests on this truth

Titus 2:15

15 These things speak, and exhort, and rebuke with all authority. Let no man despise thee. $\ensuremath{\mathsf{KJV}}$

2 Tim 4:2-4

- 2 Preach the word; be instant in season, out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort with all longsuffering and doctrine.
- 3 For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine; but after their own lusts shall they heap to themselves teachers, having itching ears;
- 4 And they shall turn away their ears from the truth, and shall be turned unto fables. KJV
