INTRODUCTION

Forwarded article:

History has it that when the ancient Chinese decided to live in peace, they made the Great Wall of China. They thought no one could climb it due to its height.

During the first 100 years of its existence, the Chinese were invaded thrice and every time, the hordes of enemy infantry had no need of penetrating or climbing over the wall, because each time, they bribed the guards and came through the doors.

The Chinese built the wall, but forgot the character - building of the wall-guards. Though the Great Wall has over the years become a powerful symbol of the country's enduring strength and spirit, but it has actually been a good reminder to the Chinese of the superiority of human character.

A) The outworking of what God works in us

16 Holding forth the word of life; that I may rejoice in the day of Christ, that I have not run in vain, neither laboured in vain.

This means

- **A continuous outworking**

It does not matter if you go fast or slow;

Or if you reach the top or not...

Just keep doing...do not stop...

Keep pressing on..

Keep being steadfast, unmovable, abounding in the work of the Lord

- **A working out that leads to our deliverance**

2) We get to be in Christ through His word

Phil 2:5

The mind of Christ is such that He humbled Himself and purchased for us our redemption. Our salvation is not conditioned upon any meritorious act of our own but upon His act alone. While our salvation is free for us, it is not cheap for the Lord Jesus Christ.

Christ then should be our standard. As He lived a perfect life for us, we need to pattern and measure our lives according to His perfect life.

1 Peter 2:21-24

21 For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:

22 Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

23 Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously:

24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.

c) To walk as He walked
