## BODY

We need to respond to every act of God upon our lives so that we can show His glory in us... Here are some Biblical responses...

### 1) The Goodness of God

Rom 2:4

4 Or despisest thou the riches of his goodness and forbearance and longsuffering; not knowing that the goodness of God leadeth thee to repentance?

2 Peter 3:9

9 The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.

### Lighthouse BBC 7-point Guidelines in the face of COVID-19

God's people should not be surprised by the things that happen in this world. 1 Peter 4:12 says, "Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you."

We are not left without guidance as people of God. Let us all be aware of the following.

**1) Be knowledgeable. Do not be overcome by fear. Do not panic. Be aware of factual news. Do not share unvalidated social media topics. Remember IEC - information, education, communication.**

Hosea 4:6, "...My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge."

**2) Be healthy. Boost your immune system. Take a lot of Vit C. Supplement with A, B, D, Zinc. Reduce sugar and carb. Eat a balanced diet. Exercise. Sleep.**

3 John 1:2, "Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth."

#### Ways to boost your immune system.

- ✓ Boost your Vit C intake. Recommend Sodium Ascorbate to be diluted in water. Remember however that this is not recommended for those who have kidney stones. Take citrus fruits, green leafy veggies (kangkong, malunggay, lettuce).

- ✓ Take supplementary Vit A, B, D, Zinc
- ✓ Reduce your intake of rice and barbs
- ✓ Exercise in the morning sun.
- ✓ Have sufficient sleep.
- ✓ Do not fear.

**3) Be clean. Observe a good hygiene. Wash hands often. Beware of what things you touch and handle. Observe social distancing. Face masks are better worn only by those who have colds, cough.**

Remember that in Lighthouse BBC, lobby entrances are disinfected. Hand disinfectant bottles are placed in all lobby entrances.

**4) Be aware of your limits if you have low immune system. Wear mask. Masks are better worn by those who feel sick or have low immune system. Know who comes within 1 meter distance from you. If you feel the following: dry cough, sore throat, hoarse voice, headache, diarrhea, muscle pain, fatigue, difficulty in breathing and fever, do self-quarantine immediately. Trace the people you had close contact with within 4 feet.**

**5) Be aware that the enemy is the novel corona virus (2019-nCoV). This is what needs to be contained. To contain the same, social distancing must be done.**

**6) Be vigilant in all things. Readiness and proper response is of prime importance.**

1 Peter 5:8, "Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour."

Rom 13:11-14, "And that, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep: for now is our salvation nearer than when we believed.

The night is far spent, the day is at hand: let us therefore cast off the works of darkness, and let us put on the armour of light. Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying. But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfil the lusts thereof."
