Acts 20:32

32 And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of his grace, which is able to build you up, and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

28 For which of you, intending to build a tower, sitteth not down first, and counteth the cost, whether he have sufficient to finish it?

- 1) **We need to hear, receive, believe, obey and made practical the word of grace in our lives as an Ekklesia.**

The Ephesian believers heard, received, believed, trusted this word.

Eph 1:12-13

13 In whom ye also trusted, after that ye heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: in whom also after that ye believed, ye were sealed with that holy Spirit of promise,

In doing so, we have faith.

The cleansing and sanctifying power of the word makes...

a) A glorious church

Glorious because of the grace and truth in Christ

John 1:14-17

14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
15 John bare witness of him, and cried, saying, This was he of whom I spake, He that cometh after me is preferred before me: for he was before me.
16 And of his fulness have all we received, and grace for grace.
17 For the law was given by Moses, but grace and truth came by Jesus Christ.

c) A church without wrinkle

Definition of wrinkle

d) A church holy and without blemish

Phil 2:15
