1 Chron 4:9-10

9 And Jabez was more honourable than his brethren: and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, Because I bare him with sorrow.

10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.

INTRODUCTION

1 Chron 4:9-10

9 And Jabez was more honourable than his brethren: and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, Because I bare him with sorrow.

10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep me from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.

What we know of Jabez.

He was an honorable man.

He was a prayerful man.

He was a man who was blessed indeed.

But the entry of point of Jabez into this world was through her mother who delivered him in sorrow, in pain. And it was his own mother who gave him such a name Jabez, “because she bore him with sorrow. His name practically means “sorrow maker.”

But from that sorrow came an honorable man. A prayerful man. A man blessed indeed.

The rest that is known about him was that he came from the tribe of Judah, the lineage of Christ, and he was a learned man, having a whole town named after him, a town where scribes came from...

1 Chron 2:55

55 **And the families of the scribes which dwelt at Jabez;** the Tirathites, the Shimeathites, and Suchathites. These are the Kenites that came of Hemath, the father of the house of Rechab.

Jabez and his Mother

A mother in sorrow

John 16:21-22

21 A woman when she is in travail hath sorrow, because her hour is come: but as soon as she is delivered of the child, she remembereth no more the anguish, for joy that a man is born into the world.

A) He became a man of prayer. He was taught to pray.

B) His land became a land of scribes. He obviously was taught the commandments of the Lord.

1 Chron 2:55

55 And the families of the scribes which dwelt at Jabez; the Tirathites, the Shimeathites, and Suchathites. These are the Kenites that came of Hemath, the father of the house of Rechab.

Concerning the history of Jabez, Dr F. Whitfield of The Pulpit Commentary wrote, "Supposed to be the son of Kenaz, and an eminent doctor of the law, whose reputation drew around him so many scribes and learned men that a town was called by his name (see 1 Chron 2:55)."

The reference to "the families of the scribes" in 1 Chron 2:55 indicates the forming of guilds and the passing down of the scribal profession from father to son.

2 And he said unto his mother, The eleven hundred shekels of silver that were taken from thee, about which thou cursedst, and spakest of also in mine ears, behold, the silver is with me; I took it. And his mother said, Blessed be thou of the Lord, my son.
