What we need to buy. What we need to have as an Ekklesia. We need to buy from Christ that which will make us to be enriched in works. This was the main problem of the Laodicean church... they weighted everything on possessions and not on works.

It was in their works in which the Lord found them to be lukewarm. They did not do acceptably. They could not...they simply became so sufficient in saying I have all the goods I need.

BODY

A) Gold tried in fire that thou mayest be rich

1) Gold tried in fire. A valuable life made rich by the proving and trial of faith.

1 Cor 3:12-15

12 Now if any man build upon this foundation gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, stubble;

13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

14 If any man's work abide which he hath built thereupon, he shall receive a reward.

15 If any man's work shall be burned, he shall suffer loss: but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire.

14 And above all these things put on charity, which is the bond of perfectness.
15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful.
16 Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord.

The church at Laodicea was not exempted from temptations and sins. In fact, to deal with this, the Apostle Paul wrote them an epistle but somewhere, this letter was not found.

Col 4:16-17

16 And when this epistle is read among you, cause that it be read also in the church of the Laodiceans; and that ye likewise read the epistle from Laodicea.
17 And say to Archippus, Take heed to the ministry which thou hast received in the Lord, that thou fulfil it.

We can only glean from the letter to Colosse regarding what the Laodicean church faced...

3 In whom are hid all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
4 And this I say, lest any man should beguile you with enticing words.
5 For though I be absent in the flesh, yet am I with you in the spirit, joying and beholding your order, and the stedfastness of your faith in Christ.
6 As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him:
7 Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving.
8 Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ.
9 For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily.
10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power:

Obviously, they were taken by the standards of measurement of this world... the philosophy, vain deceit after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of this world and not after Christ. The Lord did not write a letter to the church in Colosse!

Because of this, the Laodicean church became so detached, self sufficient. And anything that would correct them, they would say, We're fine. Leave us alone. They did not know that they had become poor, miserable, wretched, blind, naked....

They were full of themselves and have eased out the Lord from their midst.

When the nakedness of our sinful flesh becomes manifested because of sin, we need clothing. We need His peace. That is what the clothing of righteousness gives us...

Rom 14:17

17 For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.
