20 A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent.

BODY

1) We have blessedness that come by being forgiven and being made righteous before Him

Ps 32:1-2

1 Blessed is he whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered.

2 Blessed is the man unto whom the Lord imputeth not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile.

This is righteousness that comes by faith, as exemplified by Abraham, the faith of faith.

Gal 3:7-9

7 Know ye therefore that they which are of faith, the same are the children of Abraham.

8 And the scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the heathen through faith, preached before the gospel unto Abraham, saying, In thee shall all nations be blessed.

9 So then they which be of faith are blessed with faithful Abraham.

As Abraham was made righteous because of faith, we also are made righteous, our sins forgiven by the faith in Christ.
