INTRODUCTION

The calling of God is one of the most misunderstood subjects in all circles of believers, churches even Baptists. Some even make use of this calling to go against others, or to propel themselves before and above others.

1 Cor 7:20-24
 20 Let every man abide in the same calling wherein he was called.
 21 Art thou called being a servant? care not for it: but if thou mayest be made free, use it rather.
 22 For he that is called in the Lord, being a servant, is the Lord's freeman: likewise also he that is called, being free, is Christ's servant.
 23 Ye are bought with a price; be not ye the servants of men.
 24 Brethren, let every man, wherein he is called, therein abide with God.
 KJV

And some use even the verses without actually knowing the import of such verses:

Matt 20:16 16 So the last shall be first, and the first last: for many be called, but few chosen. KJV

Matt 22:14

14 For many are called, but few are chosen.

Rom 11:29-36

29 For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance.

30 For as ye in times past have not believed God, yet have now obtained mercy through their unbelief:

31 Even so have these also now not believed, that through your mercy they also may obtain mercy.

32 For God hath concluded them all in unbelief, that he might have mercy upon all.

33 O the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God! how unsearchable are his judgments, and his ways past finding out!

But what are we?

1 Peter 2:9-10

The calling of God is definitely one subject that will make us to stand fast and serve Him as free in 2023. It is the one important subject that if we give diligence to know, to make sure, the Apostle Peter says, "if ye do these things, ye shall never fall."

2 Peter 1:10-12

10 Wherefore the rather, brethren, give diligence to make your calling and election sure: for if ye do these things, ye shall never fall:

11 For so an entrance shall be ministered unto you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

12 Wherefore I will not be negligent to put you always in remembrance of these things, though ye know them, and be established in the present truth.

BODY

It is central to understanding what is past, what is present and future.

Rom 8:29-30

29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

30 Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified. KJV

One cannot have an understanding of the foreknowledge and predestination without first appreciating the calling of God.

There is so little revelation in the Bible on foreknowledge and predestination that it is hard to look into these except through the subject of calling.

1 Peter 1:2

2 Elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, through sanctification of the Spirit, unto obedience and sprinkling of the blood of Jesus Christ: Grace unto you, and peace, be multiplied. KJV

Acts 2:22-23

22 Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know: 23 Him, being delivered by the determinate counsel and foreknowledge of God, ye have taken, and by wicked hands have crucified and slain: KJV

Eph 1:4-6

4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. KJV

Eph 1:10-12

10 That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him:

Yes, we can find these terms in the Bible but to understand these subjects apply to us as His people, we find it hard to understand.

2 Peter 3:16-18

The calling of God is, too, central into understanding the real import and significant of justification and glorification.

Rom 8:33-34

33 Who shall lay any thing to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth. 34 Who is he that condemneth? It is Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us. KJV

Rom 3:25-26

25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

26 To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

Rom 5:9

9 Much more then, being now justified by his blood, we shall be saved from wrath through him. $\ensuremath{\mathsf{KJV}}$

Gal 3:8-9

A) The calling of God

1) The calling of God is made in and through Christ, His Son.

Eph 1:17-23

17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him:

18 The eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that ye may know what is the hope of his calling, and what the riches of the glory of his inheritance in the saints,

19 And what is the exceeding greatness of his power to usward who believe, according to the working of his mighty power,

20 Which he wrought in Christ, when he raised him from the dead, and set him at his own right hand in the heavenly places,

21 Far above all principality, and power, and might, and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this world, but also in that which is to come:

22 And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church, 23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all. KJV

Phil 3:14

14 I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. $\ensuremath{\mathsf{KJV}}$

2) The calling of God is a call to His glory.

2 Thess 1:11-12

11 Wherefore also we pray always for you, that our God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfil all the good pleasure of his goodness, and the work of faith with power: 12 That the name of our Lord Jesus Christ may be glorified in you, and ye in him, according to the

3) The calling of God is made according to His purpose and grace.

2 Tim 1:9

b) Called to be saints.

Rom 1:7

7 To all that be in Rome, beloved of God, called to be saints: Grace to you and peace from God our Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Cor 1:2

2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called to be saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours: KJV

c) Called to the fellowship of His dear Son.

1 Cor 1:9 9 God is faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord. KJV

d) Called to liberty.

Gal 5:13

13 For, brethren, ye have been called unto liberty; only use not liberty for an occasion to the flesh, but by love serve one another. KJV

e) Called in one body.

Col 3:15

15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful. KJV

f) Called to His kingdom and glory.

1 Thess 2:12

12 That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory. $\ensuremath{\mathsf{KJV}}$

g) Called to holiness.

1 Thess 4:7

7 For God hath not called us unto uncleanness, but unto holiness. KJV

h) Called by the Gospel

2 Thess 2:14

14 Whereunto he called you by our gospel, to the obtaining of the glory of our Lord Jesus Christ. KJV

i) Called to the good fight of faith

1 Tim 6:12

12 Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, whereunto thou art also called, and hast professed a good profession before many witnesses. KJV

j) Called from darkness into His marvelous light.

1 Peter 2:9 9 But ye are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, an holy nation, a peculiar people; that ye should shew forth the praises of him who hath called you out of darkness into his marvellous light: KJV

k) Called to follow His example and steps.

Peter 2:21-23
 For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps:
 Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

23 Who, when he was reviled, reviled not again; when he suffered, he threatened not; but committed himself to him that judgeth righteously: KJV

l) Called to be a blessing.

1 Peter 3:9

9 Not rendering evil for evil, or railing for railing: but contrariwise blessing; knowing that ye are thereunto called, that ye should inherit a blessing. KJV

m) Called to his eternal glory by Christ Jesus.

1 Peter 5:10

10 But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle you. KJV

n) Called to glory and virtue.

2 Peter 1:3

3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: KJV

All these Biblical passages point to just one reason:

B) The Grace in the Calling

1) The call of God is effectual because he bestowed grace to everyone He called.

Rom 11:29

29 For the gifts and calling of God are without repentance. $\ensuremath{\mathsf{KJV}}$

2 Timothy 1:9 (KJV) Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,

1 Thessalonians 2:12 (KJV) That ye would walk worthy of God, who hath called you unto his kingdom and glory.

Galatians 1:15 (KJV) But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by his grace,

2 Thessalonians 1:11-12 (KJV)

Whom He justified, He glorifed

Eph 1:7

7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; KJV

Eph 1:12 12 That we should be to the praise of his glory, who first trusted in Christ. KJV

2) The working of grace in those He called.

We all have fallen short of the glory of God.

Rom 3:23 23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; KJV

But by His grace, we are not only saved but His glory is made to be in us.

Eph 1:6-7

6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted in the beloved. 7 In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace; KJV



Be worthy of Christ and all His grace in Him.
